Whereas, CUESA and its community of farmers and artisans are committed to cultivating a sustainable food system that are good for people and the planet; and

Whereas, the Ferry Plaza Farmers Market has successfully created direct marketing opportunities for small California family farms and regional food artisans, many of whom have been selling at the market the entire 20 years; and

Whereas, the Ferry Plaza Farmers Market has helped to revitalize the San Francisco downtown waterfront by consistently attracting over 1.5 million shoppers each year; and

Whereas, the Ferry Plaza Farmers Market serves as a hub for the Bay Area culinary community by connecting chefs with one another and with farmers; and
